1.0 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 Wwww.rehmgrinaker.mu is owned by REHM Grinaker Construction Co. Ltd (hereafter “**RG**”) and is operated, hosted, and maintained by Web Ltd. This website uses cookies.
- 1.2 Our Cookie Policy explains what cookies are and how we use them. You should read this policy so that you can understand what type of cookies we use, the information we collect using cookies and how that information is used.
- 1.3 In this notice, "we", "us" and "our" refer to RG.

2.0 WHAT ARE COOKIES

- 2.1 Cookies are small data files that a website places on your computer or mobile device which member information about users and website usage, such as language preference or login information for a certain period of time. In this way, cookies can help a website deliver a more user-friendly service since users will not need to insert their details again and again when browsing around the site during the same visit.

3.0 USE OF COOKIES

3.1 Types of cookies

- 3.1.1 A cookie can be classified by its lifespan, purpose and the domain to which it belongs.

3.2 Session and Persistent Cookies

- 3.2.1 By lifespan, cookies can be either persistent cookies or session cookies. A persistent cookie will be stored by a web browser and will remain valid until its set expiry date, unless deleted by the user before the expiry date; while a session cookie will expire at the end of the user session when the web browser is closed.

- 3.2.2 We use both session and persistent cookies.

3.3 First party cookies and third-party cookies.

- 3.3.1 There are either first party cookies, set by our website, or third-party cookies which are placed on your device through our website by external parties. Please refer to Section 5 of this policy for more details on the third-party cookies available on our website.

3.4 Why do we use the following cookies?

- 3.4.1 Strictly necessary / essential cookies.

These are essential cookies enabled for the proper functioning of our website and used to perform basic functions. Without these cookies, our website may not function as intended. For this reason, they do not require your consent.

3.4.2 Analytics / Performance cookies

Performance and / or analytics cookies usually collect aggregated information that does not personally identify individuals but instead provides statistical information about how visitors use our website. We use these purely for internal research on how we can improve the service we provide for all our users. Also, this data is not shared with any third parties or used for any other purpose.

The list of performance/ analytical cookies our website uses are:

_utma	This cookie is used to distinguish users and sessions and is updated every time data is sent to Google Analytics.	First-party cookie, 2 years	persistent
_utmb	This cookie is used to determine new sessions/visits and is updated every time data is sent to Google Analytics.	First-party cookie, 30 minutes	persistent
_utmc	This cookie operates in conjunction with the utmb cookie to determine whether the user was in a new session/visit.	First-party cookie, end of browsing session	session
_utmt	This cookie is used to throttle request rate.	First-party cookie, 10 minutes	persistent
_utmv	This cookie is used to store visitor-level custom variable data and is updated every time data is sent to Google Analytics.	First-party cookie, 2 years	persistent
_utmz	This cookie stores the traffic or campaign that explains how the user reached the site and is updated every time data is sent to Google Analytics.	First-party cookie, 6 months	persistent

3.4.3 Functional cookies

Functional cookies are generally present to support site functionality that is visible or advantageous to the user or their experience of the site. They enable websites to remember choices and provide a more personalized experience.

The list of functional cookies our website uses are:

has_js	This cookie is used when a browser renders a page generated by Drupal, a piece of JavaScript is executed which adds a cookie. This cookie allows Drupal to generate different mark-up depending on whether the user agent is capable of executing JavaScript or not.	First-party cookie, end of browsing session.	session

Cookies-agreed	The purpose is to enable the site to remember the user's preferences for a certain period of time.	3 months

3.4.4 Targeting cookies

Targeting (advertising) cookies are set for the purpose of managing the performance of adverts, displaying adverts, and/or building user profiles. Typically, these cookies would be set by third parties that buy ad space on our website. They do not directly store personal information but are based on uniquely identifying your browser and internet device. If you do not allow these cookies, you will experience less targeted advertising.

4.0 THIRD PARTY COOKIE

- 4.1 Third-party cookies are cookies that are stored under a different domain than you are currently visiting. They are mostly used to track users between websites and display more relevant ads between websites. An example is a support chat functionality provided by a 3rd party service.

5.0 MANAGING COOKIES

- 5.1 You can manage/ reject/ delete cookies as you wish by changing your browser settings or by clearing your browsing history. Please note that most browsers automatically accept cookies so if you do not wish cookies to be used you may need to actively delete or block the cookies.
- 5.2 If you disable performance and targeting cookies, it is possible that any advertising you receive will be less targeted as a result, but the site should function correctly. However, if you disable strictly necessary and/ or functional cookies, you may be unable to access certain areas of our website and certain functions or pages will not work in the usual way. You will also lose some saved information, for instance e.g. saved login details and site preferences.

6.0 CHANGES TO THIS COOKIE POLICY

- 6.1 We keep our Cookie Policy under regular review and we may update it from time to time. We will notify you of significant changes by email or through automatic pop-ups on our website.
